### The Work

We rejoice that our attendances have held up and even increased during a bitter cold winter. With temperatures as low as -15 F, it has made life a challenge. We praise the Lord for His care over us. There have been over sixty deaths reported here in Romania due to the cold. Our water was off for over two weeks due to a main water pipe frozen in our section of town. We managed fine by carrying water up the hill from creek to bathe, melting snow to flush the toilets and carrying drinking water from a nearby spring fountain. This gave me the occasion to tell Suzanna and Amy how good they have had it and remind them once again how hard it was when I was growing up. (You know the story... walked seven miles to school in the snow, all year round, up hill both ways and was grateful just to be alive.) Their response was "yeah Dad we've heard it all before." We thank the Lord for the opportunity to work in His Vineyard.
